
This week your child was learning about: Hanukkah

This week our word is: Respect



Numeracy: Shape, Space, Measure


Capacity

This week the children discussed weights. Using the language of heavier, less heavy, light, more than and less than the children explored how an objects weight effects how it feels and reacts to things. We used scales and the water tray to show how heavier items get weighed down (sink) but lighter ones go up (float).

This week we learned the sounds z, zz and qu,




How you can help your child at home:

Practice the sounds of the week, try writing some of the words from above the contain the sounds of the week with your child. Even practicing writing the sound on its own will help your child gain confidence in their writing.

Practice children's lines and songs for the nativity at home.

Practice discussing weight. During bath time you can play your own sink or float game with your child.
