


This week your child was learning about: Art and Artists

Literacy

Topic: Art and Artist



How you can help your child at home:

Practice writing as much as you can. We are starting to teach the children the pre-cursive style, so encourage this at home.



Also work on having them learn all their site words:

No, go, I, the, to, he, she, we, be, was, you, they, all, are, my, her, said, have, like, so, do, some, come, where, there, little, one, when, out, what

Practice Ask your child what time it is! It will be fun to find out what time of the day they do specific things: eat breakfast, go to school, have dinner, go to bed etc.
