

Topic: Space

To end the term we thought it would be fun to discuss with the children all the places where they could go and may not be able to but would like to go, like outer space. We discussed how this is a great journey we can take together, much like their soon to be journey to Year 1. We talked about our fears and what we could be excited about.



How you can help your child at home:

Practice writing as much as you can. We are starting to teach the children the pre-cursive style, so encourage this at home.

Practice the red words and sounds that have been posted above. These will help your children while they are reading.

Practice their number bonds to 10 and find 1 more and 1 less of any given number.

Practice Finding 3D shapes in your home environment. Encourage the children to use the 3D shape names: **sphere, cylinder, pyramid, cone, rectangular prism, cube, and triangular prism.**

Things to remember:

- **Remember!** Please send your child in with a **water bottle** that is marked with their name. We do not have individual cups for them to drink water in class. Also bring **hats** and **sun cream** if you like your child to be protected from the sun. In these warmer days we are often outside.
