We have a right to feel safe and to be safe on the Internet.

We will respect this right by reporting anything that we don't feel comfortable with to an adult.

We have the right to have access to ICT equipment.

We have the right to explore, find things out and share what we think unless it harms or offends other people.

We will respect this right by researching responsibly and making sure that any posts or comments that we write are fair and kind.

We have a right for people to show us respect on the Internet and not to be bothered or bullied by others.

We will respect this right reporting any unkind behaviour online to an adult and ensure that we always treat others fair and kind.

We have the right to reliable information from the media and computers. Adults should help us to understand this information.

We will respect this right by using our distilling skills to find the best information and asking for help if we do not understand.

We have the right to join groups and organisations with permission from an adult.

We will respect this right by making sure that we always check with an adult before joining any online groups. When we communicate on our Blog we will make sure that we are always kind and fair to others.

We have the right to privacy and to keep all information about us private when using the internet.

We will respect other people's right to their own passwords and only use ICT when we are logged in as ourselves. We will not disclose our personal information when online.
