Dear Parents and Carers

SWIMMING for Year 3 pupils in Maple Class – begins Thursday 28 February to 4 July 2019

Your child #name will begin swimming sessions every Thursday morning at Royal Russell School, travelling by bus and tram, starting from Thursday 28th February until Thursday 4th July. Your child is still expected to start school at their normal time, school gates open at 8:45am.

Your son/daughter will need to bring a towel and swimming trunks/costume each week, and will need to WEAR A SWIMMING CAP IF HE/SHE HAS LONG HAIR.

Swimming is part of the National Curriculum and every child must take part in lessons unless there is a medical reason. A note of explanation to your child's teacher would be appreciated if your child were unwell and unable to participate in a class. We would require a doctor's letter if your child's illness persists and he/she misses more than **2** swimming lessons in a row.

EARRINGS must be REMOVED and children are not to swim with OPEN WOUNDS or if wearing PLASTERS.

Also, if your child has been absent during the weekly sessions before, they will not be allowed to go swimming that week.
